WHAT DO STUDENTS ACHIEVE?

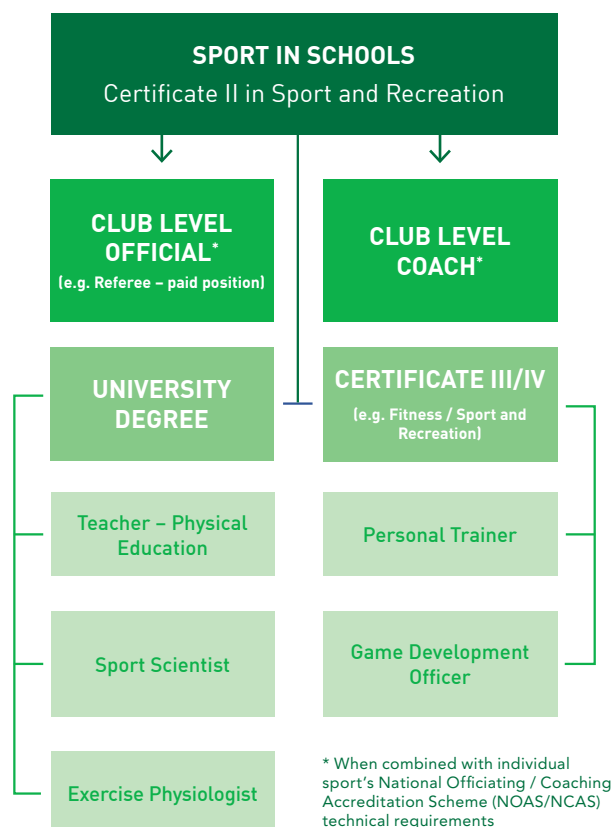
- SIS20115 Certificate II in Sport and Recreation (max. 4 QCE credits)
