

# Types of Businesses

## Product-based Businesses

- **Food** - Snacks at school like cakes and treats, sausage sizzles, sushi and toasties.
- **Drinks** - smoothies, loaded milkshakes, juices or other drinks.
- **Upcycled** - utilise unused materials like wood, plastic or metal to make homewares such as breadboards or jewellery hangers. This can include repurposing material to make clothes and bags.
- **Recycled** - utilise used materials to make something like jewellery, phone covers, photo frames, bags, fruit bowls and storage devices.
- **New** - purchase products online for wholesale or bulk prices and then resell in their local community. Such as beauty kits, sporting goods, apparel and stationery goods.
- **Art / digital** - utilising existing creative skills to create products like cards, calendars, stationery goods and websites.
- **Handmade** - buy all raw ingredients and make products like bath bombs, lip balms, body scrubs, and candles.
- **Rental** - purchase a well-used product and then rent it out to the customer such as blankets, books, DVDs and video games.
- **Delivery** - offer a delivery element to their product such as food, coffee, or love packages like flowers or chocolates.
- **Pets** - pet-related products like treats, food, accessories like or outfits or collars.

## Service-based Businesses

- **Cleaning** - local services that clean cars, windows, houses and bins.
- **Memberships** - coordinate sport competitions or clubs that customers pay to participate in. This may include physical sport or video game competitions.
- **Pet walking** - providing a walking service in blocks of time with allocated costs that increase with duration.
- **Tutoring** - provide academic tutoring to assist junior levels with their homework and learning.
- **Makeup and hair** - offer temporary hairstyles and styling for fellow students to show off at school using products such as chalk and hairspray, and creating styles such as blow waves and braids.
- **Digital design** - utilising existing digital literacy skills to assist customers with digital aspects like website design, logo design, social media accounts and platforms.
- **Photography** - utilising existing skills in photography to take portrait shots or be the professional photographer at parties or social gatherings.
- **Restaurant /cafe** - operate small restaurants or cafes that host breakfast, lunch or dinner sessions.
