- Entry requirement includes completion of SIS20115 Certificate II in Sport and Recreation
- Includes Provide First Aid/CPR certificates; accreditations in coaching and officiating
- Available in sport specialty formats where students complete a sport-specific accreditation in coaching/officiating



WHAT DO STUDENTS ACHIEVE?

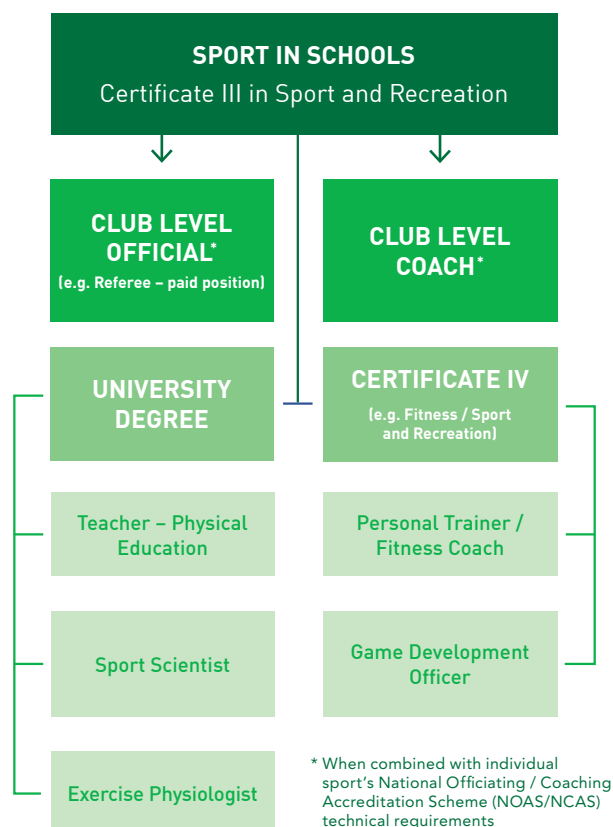
- SIS30115 Certificate III in Sport and Recreation (max. 7 QCE credits)
- Entry qualification: SIS20115 Certificate II in Sport and Recreation
- Provide First Aid/CPR certificates
- Officiating AND coaching accreditation
- Students eligible for an Australian Tertiary Admission Rank (ATAR) may be able to use their completed Certificate III to contribute towards their ATAR
