

VET AND INDUSTRY QUALIFICATION / PD REQUIREMENTS First Aid and CPR Courses

Each program deliverer must have the following evidence requirements in place prior to the commencement of delivery:

CURRENT FIRST AID & CPR TAE **VCU HLTAID011 Provide First Aid HLTAID009** Provide cardiopulmonary resuscitation Hold the Certificate IV in Training and Assessment (TAE40122; TAE40116; TAE40110*) qualification: * If using the TAE40110 qualification, the following two units must also be Certificate IV in held: **Training and** 1. TAEASS502 Design and develop assessment tools (or equivalent); and **Assessment** 2. TAELLN411 Address adult language, literacy and numeracy (LLN) skills (or equivalent). Or hold a diploma or higher qualification in 'adult' education. **Industry Qualification** Hold a current Provide First Aid Certificate (within 3 years) and CPR (Current First Aid and Certificate (within 12 months). These must remain current for each new class CPR) being delivered. First Aid program deliverers are required to complete a (free) non-accredited Vocational Competence Update (VCU) each year, specific to the nationally recognised First Aid unit of competency: HLTAID011 Provide First Aid. Vocational The First Aid VCU is designed so that Binnacle program deliverers can demonstrate their recent First Aid work history using a Statement of Service Competence which is verified electronically by a nominated third party (person). This VCU will also include PD to satisfy Binnacle Training's annual

Industry and VET PD requirements for First Aid program deliverers.
