

In accordance with **Clauses 1.17 - 1.20** of the Standards for RTOs 2015, a trainer who does not hold the required competencies as a trainer and assessor must:

- Be supervised by a qualified trainer to maintain the quality of training and assessment.
- The Trainer must hold at least one of the Trainer Skill Sets below to be able to continue delivery; and
- Must not determine assessment outcomes (can assist with making assessment decisions only).
