• **TAE**. The teacher must currently hold, or will complete <u>prior to student enrolment</u>, the Certificate IV in Training and Assessment (TAE40122, TAE40116 or TAE40110*) qualification.

* Where the teacher holds TAE40110, two new core units must also be held:

- TAEASS502 Design and develop assessment tools (or equivalent); and
- TAELLN411 Address adult language, literacy and numeracy (LLN) skills (or equivalent)

The teacher must be a registered secondary school teacher who currently holds, or will complete prior to student enrolment, one of the following Skill Sets:

- <u>TAESS00019</u> Assessor Skill Set (comprises 3 of the 12 units from the full TAE qualification)
- <u>TAESS00024</u> VET Delivered to School Students Teacher Enhancement Skill Set (comprises 5 of the 12 units from the full TAE qualification: Assessor Skill Set per above + 2 additional units)

The teacher must hold a diploma or higher qualification in "adult" education.

- **INDUSTRY QUALIFICATION**. The teacher must first hold an industry qualification i.e. VET qualification (at the qualification level or higher) and/or degree in that industry area. Additionally,
 - Certificate III in Fitness 'program deliverers' must hold a Certificate IV in Fitness (or be a registered/accredited practising exercise professional).
 - Certificate II in Tourism 'program deliverers' (dual qualification and standalone programs) must specifically hold a 'Tourism, Hospitality or Events' relevant VET qualification (Certificate II or higher) and/or degree.
- <u>VCU</u>. Teachers are required to complete a (free) non-accredited Vocational Competence Update (VCU) which is used to demonstrate current knowledge and skills specific to each unit of competency within the qualification being delivered. Teachers will need to either:
 - hold the unit of competency (same unit code or equivalent) <u>OR</u>
 - demonstrate equivalence (in skills and knowledge) using verifiable evidence. This 'demonstration of equivalence' requires a third-party verifier which can be a supervisor or HOD in the school environment (must be in an industry context) plus, for select units only, other supporting evidence (e.g. completed risk assessment).

* All 2025 Certificate II in Tourism deliverers must have undertaken a recent Tourism-related industry placement (minimum 1 day) prior to commencement of their VCU and course delivery.
